Preliminary and Final Site Plan Approval Application Checklist

- Review, Completed and Signed Site Plan Review Application
 - Read all sections
 - Attach narrative
- Fees Paid to Clinton County Regional Planning Commission
 - Fees are calculated as: \$500 + \$0.05/sq.ft. of new, impervious development area (building footprints and paved areas primarily)
- All Required Site Plan Drawings:
 - Site Overview (show building locations, ingress/egress, parking areas, location of equipment/mechanical systems, etc.)
 - Landscaping Overview (can be incorporated into Site Overview)
 - Elevation drawings/renderings showing proposed building/architectural designs.
 - Lighting Plan showing extent of any proposed exterior lighting (particularly as it affects adjacent properties).
 - Signage Plans/Designs
- Agency Approvals
 - Stormwater Review

 - Pay stormwater review fees prior to RPC meeting.
- Access Management/Traffic Impact

- Zoning Department
